

What About Singles?



"Does JG hire single guards, too?"

We specialize in 24/7 Onsite Team Security. However, we do occasionally have opportunities for single guards.

"How are 'Solo' assignments different?"

These positions are usually 12-14 hours shifts, vehicle-based, and can include or be limited to night shifts.



"Where do I park my RV?"

Traditional Security generally dictates that the guard live nearby, or park his/her RV offsite, and commute to location. Pay rates do reflect this.

"Do I still need a license?"

Yes. We guide our guards through obtaining a Level 2 Security License. Don't worry: it's easy!

"What's the uniform?"

We typically provide a JG collared shirt and reflective vest. Shoes should always be closed-toe. We ask that you wear black or khaki pants.

"How long are these assignments?"

Security is usually contracted for the length of a specific project. Could last weeks, months, or indefinitely.

"How do I move forward?"

Solo applications are filed by proximity, and our Recruiting Department reaches out if a position becomes available.



It is entirely up to you whether or not to pursue your Level 2 Security License, but having it is necessary to be eligible for such positions.
