

What About Singles?

"Does JG contract single guards, too?"

We specialize in Team Security. However, we do occasionally have opportunities for 12-hour guards, too.



"How are 'Solo' assignments different?"

These contract assignments are usually 12-14 hour shifts, vehicle-based, and can include or be limited to night shifts.

"Where do I park my RV?"

Traditional Security generally dictates that the guard live nearby, or park his/her RV offsite, and commute to location.

Pay rates do reflect this.

"Do I still need a license?"

Yes. We guide our contract guards through obtaining a Level 2 Security License.
Don't worry: it's easy!

"What's the uniform?"

We typically provide a JG collared polo and reflective vest. These sites usually require safety-toed shoes. *We ask that you wear black, blue or khaki tactical pants.*



"How long are these contract assignments?"

Security is usually contracted for the length of a specific project. Project duration varies by industry and location.

"How do I move forward?"

12-hour Guard Contractor Profiles are filed by credential and proximity allowing our Contractor Onboarding Team to reach out if an assignment becomes available.

It is entirely up to you whether or not to pursue your Level 2 Security License, but having it is necessary to be eligible for such contracts.
